CMAA Zones

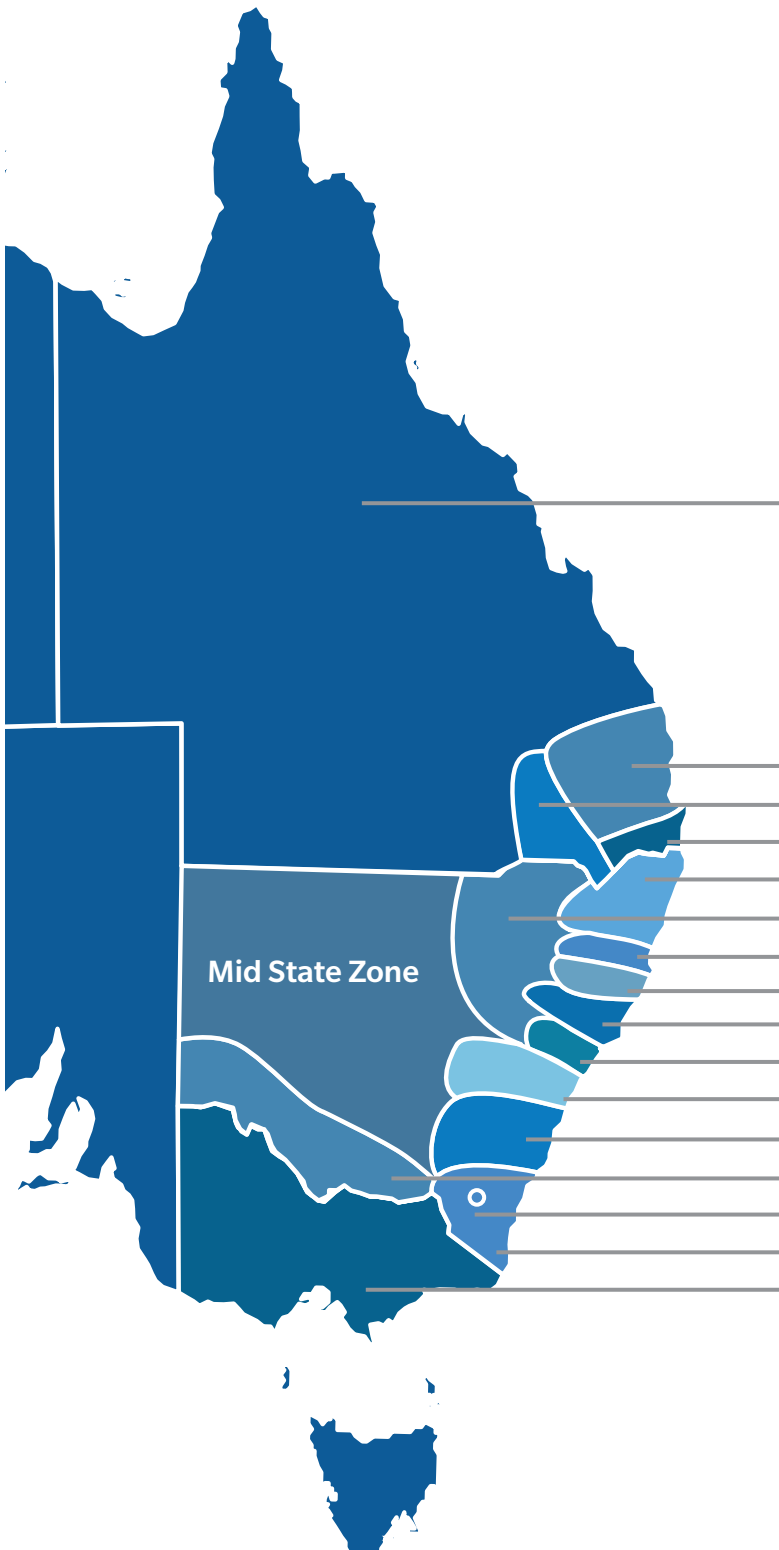
The CMAA is divided into 25 Zones spread across NSW, Queensland, Victoria & ACT.

Each CMAA Zone represents Club Managers whose clubs fall within the geographical boundaries of that Zone.

Individual CMAA Zones, generally, meet quarterly with Members to discuss relevant local, state and national issues for the Club Industry and ongoing CMAA events & activities.

Each Zone Meeting is often followed by a networking function for Members, Club Directors, Sponsors & trade partners.

As well as Zone Meetings, many Zones stage social events with Members & Sponsors (e.g. Race Days & Golf Days).

The Certified Club Manager Award (CCM)

The letters CCM signifies this prestigious industry award. To initially achieve the CCM award, applicants must meet the points and the criteria for each of the sections that make up the award i.e. Industry Experience, Industry Activity and Education. The recipient of the award will be entitled to retain this CCM status for perpetuity. Recipients will be initially granted active status of the award for a period of two years.

The Active Certified Club Manager Award (ACCM)

To either attain and/or maintain the active status of the CCM award, ACCM, Managers must be employed within the club industry, be current members of the CMAA, and provide evidence of continued Education and/or Industry Activity. This is done by collecting a minimum of 50 points over a two-year period.

How to achieve points:

- **20 points** for attending a **CMAA Annual Conference***
- **15 points** per year for **CMAA Office Bearers**
eg: Executive Boards and Zone Committee members
- **10 points** for attending a **CMAA Zone Meeting**.
- **2 points** for attending an approved **CMAA Zone Meeting Education Workshop**
- **2 points** per hour attendance at a **CMAA/CMDA Training Course/Seminar/Conference Workshop** (maximum of 25 points allocated per event)**
- **2 points** per hour attendance at a **CMAA/CMDA Partner Training Course/Seminar/Conference Workshop** (maximum of 25 points allocated per event). This includes Southern Cross University and CMDA approved partners.

*For members who attend a CMAA Annual Conference delivered more than 100km radius from their club's premises, an additional 10 points will be allocated.

** For members who attend a CMAA Training Course or seminar delivered more than 100km radius from their club's premises, an additional 5 points will be allocated.

CMDA Affiliate eligibility

You are eligible to become a CMDA Affiliate if you are not employed as a manager in a hospitality venue.

Examples of the type of job roles a CMDA Affiliate may perform include:

- bar attendant,
- waitress,
- cellarman,
- receptionist,
- catering attendant,
- supervisor and
- any other role that does not require persons performing managerial duties.

How much does it cost to join as a CMDA Affiliate?

A one off investment cost of \$280 inclusive of GST as long as you are employed and remain at the same club as an operational staff member.

When you do become a manager and are eligible to join the Club Managers Association Australia (CMAA) as a full member you can receive the full benefit of membership including:

- full professional development opportunities,
- zone meetings,
- Individual industrial representation and more.

What are the benefits to me as an individual?

- opportunity to subscribe to a professional Association for career path consultation assistance
- access to professional development

What are the benefits to the Club if it sponsors me as a CMDA Affiliate?

- access CMDA training at the CMAA members rate – a direct dollar savings recoupable within the first or second registration of a course
- for smaller clubs a demonstrable commitment by management to 'look after' the needs of supervisors/staff who can't progress to management due to restrictive opportunity or structure
- opportunity for staff to subscribe to a professional Association for career path assistance
- incentive for operational staff to drive their own career and development path and take responsibility

Some Important Fast Facts

- CMAA membership is from the 1st January to the 31st December each year for individuals that is to be paid in advance.
- Payment can be made weekly, monthly or yearly.
- Members can arrange payroll deductions weekly via their Club, however payroll must pass these fees on monthly or annually in advance to Head Office.
- Payment methods are Credit Card or Direct debit.
- EFT or Cheque payments can be made for yearly payments only.
- As of January 2016 membership fees incurred a CPI increase of 3% for the 2016 year and ongoing CPI increases per annum for the years following.
- Members who are in arrears of their membership fees 3 months or more will under the rules of the Association become unfinancial and will be contacted by CMAA HO to confirm their ongoing intention to retain membership of the CMAA.

Trainee member yearly: \$412

Full member monthly: \$48.61

Trainee member monthly: \$34.29

Full member: Weekly payroll deductions \$11.22
(payroll to pass on monthly or yearly in advance to CMAA)

Trainee: Weekly payroll deductions \$7.93
(payroll to pass on monthly or yearly in advance to CMAA)
