RULES & CONDITIONS

1. The prize will be awarded every year, and will be a **recognised accredited** Club Managers Training Conference/Seminar on the Gold Coast, which is usually held in late June. The prize value will not exceed the total sum of AU\$1,500, any other costs or expenses incurred over that limit will be at the winner's expense.
2. There will be a total of 3 winners every year.
3. All applicants must be financial members of the Club Managers Association Australia, at the time of the application.
4. All applicants must be employed within the Manly/Northern Suburbs Zone of the CMA, at the time of application, and when partaking in the seminar.
5. All applicants must include a letter of nomination from a **financial member of the Manly/Northern Suburbs Zone of the CMA, supporting the nominee's application.**
6. All applicants are to forward their application to the President of the Manly/Northern Zone of the CMA, by no later than **Friday 16th April 2010**. The application is to be placed in a sealed envelope, with their name, address and place of their employment to be noted on the back. The zone president will then forward all applications to the selection panel to determine the winner.
7. The selection committee will be made up of the Zone Federal Councillor, a CMDA representative, and one (1) industry representative chosen by the zone executive.
8. **All applicants must have attended a minimum of two (2) Manly/Northern Suburbs Zone Meetings OR two (2) Approved CMDA Courses, within the past two (2) years.**
9. All bursary winners must use their prize within 12 months of the announcement.
10. The Zone Federal Councillor or Zone President in their absence will announce the successful applicant's. All applicants will become void after the announcement of the successful applications.
11. The total cost of the Bursary Prize (\$1,500) may include registration, travel arrangements, accommodation and all other reasonable expenses approved by the Zone President and Education Officer.

WINNERS RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1) Winners are required to remain with and actively participate in the organised tour they have chosen. If the winner wishes to make other travel arrangements prior to or on completion of the tour, it will be done at their own cost.
- 2) Travel, Health Insurance, Passport and any necessary visas are the responsibility of the successful applicant.
- 3) Any expenses incurred by the successful applicants such as meals, tours outside organised study tour, portorage, transfer fees, entertainment etc, are at the applicant's expense.
