



## ACTIVE CERTIFIED CLUB MANAGERS AWARD ACCM “EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS ONLY”.

To obtain your ACCM you will require a total of 200 Professional Development Points, over a two year period. There are three pathways to achieving this.

### Component 1: Education (100 points\*)

This compulsory component is achieved by completing the Club Managers Leadership & Management. Program delivered by **elevateB** in association with Australis College (RTO31518).

### Component 2: Activity: Summits and Conferences.

You attain 30 educational points from CMAA courses & 20 points from Summits and Conferences.

2. CSA Governance Course ( max 1)
3. GMDC Course
4. Legal Compliance for Clubs
5. Marketing for the Brave
6. Duty Manager Program
7. **RMLV** course (QLD)
8. Prepare and Monitor Budgets
9. Analyse and Report on Gaming Machine Data
10. Your Leadership Impact, People and Culture

### Component 3: Other Accredited Training

You attain 30 points for each relevant unit you complete with a Registered Training Organisation(RTO). This is evidenced via Statements of Attainment or Academic Transcripts issued by the RTO. You must also be a financial member of the CMAA.
